

NORTH AYRSHIRE WATERMILL SURVEY

Present use: No trace remains of what was a farm which may have had a mill albeit the evidence so far says no. On the 1st edition OS a pond is shown nearby the farm, as it was then. The site of the farm is now a housing development, circa 1960s. Local residents remember what they knew as the curling pond but could not say/remember if there was a mill wheel at the farm. Farmers that I have spoken to all seem to think the pond was for the curling.
