

STIRLINGSHIRE:

ST. NINIAN'S PARISH.

GHOSTS KNOWE, CRAIGENGELT. This mound lies about 400 yds. ESE. of Craigengelt, the road to the farm cutting its S. edge. It is so much spread, no doubt as a result of ploughing, that its dimensions must be to some extent a matter of opinion; subject to this proviso, however, it may be said to measure about 107 ft. over all from N. to S. by about 95 ft. from E. to W., the height varying between 4 ft. 6 in. and 6 ft. according to the natural slope of the ground. An area measuring about 40 ft. in diameter on the top of the mound is flattened.

CAIRNS, CRAIGENGELT. Nothing could be seen of the other cairns noted by the New Statistical Account as existing near the Ghosts Knowe and Craigengelt, although some irregular settings of large stones, possibly the foundations of huts or enclosures, were noted in the rough field immediately NW. of the farm. There is also a mound on the N. bank of Buckie Burn about 300 yds. E. of Craigengelt, but this appears to be natural.
