Watching Brief during minor works

Report

A watching brief was maintained during the excavation of small trenches in the area of the Moss Farm stone circle. These works were intended to realign the fence protecting the monument within the confines of the guardianship area. Two holes 25cm wide and 75mm deep were dug into the subsoil 5m from the bank surrounding the stone circle. The same sequence of deposits was revealed in each trench. 15cm of peaty soil overlay 6cm of clean orange stony sand. There were no finds.
