

SUMMARY


On May 22nd and 23rd, 2017, a watching brief took place at 61 West High Street, Inverurie, Aberdeenshire in advance of construction of a retail and residential structure on an undeveloped lot. No archaeological finds or features were noted and it is therefore recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.

1 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The site (Illus 1, 2) is located on the south side of West High St (B9170) between Victoria St and Chelsea Rd. It is centred on NGR NJ77247 21623, at 55-60m OD in the parish of Inverurie.
- 1.2 The work was commissioned by Emma McIntosh, R&B Joinery. An application 2016/1372 to Aberdeenshire Council for erection of a café bar and 4 flats was passed on 7 April 2017 with an archaeology condition (condition 1) and a requirement for a watching brief during all ground disturbance.
- 1.3 All the archaeological work was carried out in the context of Scottish Planning Policy (SPP) Planning Advice Note (PAN 2/2011) and Historic Environment Scotland's Policy Statement (HESPS) which state that archaeological remains should be regarded as part of the environment to be protected and managed.

2 ARCHAEOLOGICAL BACKGROUND

- 2.1 There are no Scheduled Monuments within 1km of, and no archaeological or historic sites within, the boundary of the proposed development. The site has formed the front garden of Broomfield Cottage on the First Edition OS map (Illus 4) and remains a garden or open undeveloped sites until the present maps (Illus 5-6).
- 2.2 Inverurie is a 'lang toon' squeezed between the meanders of the Urie as it nears its confluence with the Don and the low, rolling hills of the Garioch (in the words of the 'Inverurie Poet', William Thom, ... 'whaur creepin Ury greets its mountain cousin Don'). It began as a swampy medieval caput, its motte-and-bailey castle now split and tonsured in the cemetery. Across the Don, Port Elphinstone (named after Robert Elphinstone of Logie) was the terminus of the Aberdeen Canal (1807-54) and saw the real lift-off of Inverurie. It is an entrepot and banking centre for the agricultural expansion of the Garioch, the grain girnal of Aberdeenshire, an important stop on the new turnpike, communications became enshrined in its now defunct railway works, which are still visible (Harlaw Road). It is now a thriving, bustling market town of some 19th-century grace at its centre and considerable oil-related expansion to the north. The main industries are farming, industry and oil, a blend which epitomises eastern Aberdeenshire life at the beginning of the 21st century (Shepherd 2006).
- 2.3 100m to the south of the proposed development human remains were found in this area prior to 1866 by workmen while carting sand (HER NJ72SE0031). They were thought to be remains of an executed criminal (OSNB 1866, No42, 73). There have been no recent finds in area.

2.4 The area of the proposed development is occupied by 19th to 20th-century buildings including the Post office at 33 West High St (HES NJ72SE 208), the west Parish Church (HES NJ72SE 143), the Gordon Arms Hotel (HES NJ72SE 335), Northburn House (HES NJ72SE 185) and the War Memorial (HES NJ72SE 289).

3 THE WATCHING BRIEF


On May 22nd and 23rd, 2017 a watching brief took place during groundworks in advance of a proposed development (Illus 3) at 61 West High Street, Inverurie. The lot measures approximately 10x14m and has remained undeveloped since at least the 1st edition OS map in 1869 (Illus 4). Soil stripping was carried out with a 6-ton excavator using a bladed bucket. Despite the parcel of land being undeveloped, the topsoil layer was extremely thin throughout, (less than 10cm average) with a considerable component of imported fine gravels (c. 30%). Below the topsoil layer, a clean fine yellowish-brown sandy subsoil was present throughout, within isolated areas of reddish-brown sandy-silt lenses. Very few stones or gravels were present in the subsoil, which remained homogenous throughout the maximum depths encountered (0.5m to 0.8m).

4 CONCLUSIONS

Although the lot has remained undeveloped for at least 150 years, while also being located within the historical 'lang toon' of Inverurie, the subsoil was remarkably sterile with no traces of any human activity or artefactual deposition. One modern sherd of unmarked white ceramic was noted in the topsoil/subsoil interface, while no other archaeological finds or features were noted. and it is therefore recommended that no further archaeological work is required during the current planning application.






